

Statutes for access and admission specific
to the further education Master program
Intercultural Leadership and Technology
at Clausthal University of Technology, Clausthal Executive School
as of 07/21/2020

According to § 9 of the General Statutes for Access and Admission for Consecutive and Further Education Master Programs at Clausthal University of Technology (GSA-M) (comm. TUC 2019, 81)

1) Determination of the Procedure (in relation to § 1 subpara. 2 sentence 3 GSA-M)

The above-mentioned Master program is subject to an access procedure in accordance with § 3 subpara. 2 GSA-M.

2) Commencement of Studies (in relation to § 2 subpara. 1 GSA-M)

The program can be commenced with winter or summer term. Every year, the application period ends on 09/15 and 03/15.

3) Access Requirements (§ 3 subpara. 2 sentence 2 and subpara. 5 & 6 GSA-M)

Access to this program is only possible with a Bachelor's degree in the fields of economics, economical engineering, engineering, natural sciences, informatics, mathematics or an equivalent degree with a minimum of 180 credit points.

For this Master program conducted in English, students are required to provide proof of English language ability of B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This proof could be one of the following tests:

- IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5 or
- TOEFL IBT with a minimum score of 79 or
- TOEIC 4 Skills with a minimum score of 1050

Alternatively, this proof could be shown by a degree of a study program conducted in English or by work experience of at least one year in an English-speaking country.

4) Determination of the Technical Minimum Requirements – Master (in relation to § 3 subpara. 1 sentence 3 GSA-M)

Required are proof of a successfully completed study program with a minimum of 180 ECTS and technically relevant professional experience of at least one year.

5) Commencement
